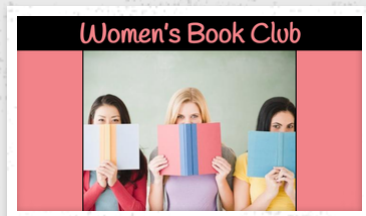
1. **Sunday School for all ages** continues with all sessions starting at **9:15 a.m.**
