# This Sunday




The **Rev. Bob Larson** will be our guest celebrant this Sunday, December 31st. Here is a brief biography -

The Reverend Robert E. Larson, Jr. (better known as Bob) is an honorably retired member of Donegal Presbytery living in Lancaster. He and his wife of 58 years, Dorothy E. Larson, (better known as Dotty) have four adult children and seven grand-children, five of whom have completed their university studies. Bob is a graduate of Wheaton College, IL, B.A., Princeton Theological Seminary, M.Div., Gettysburg Seminary, S.T.M., and Lancaster Seminary, D. Min. He also studied at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland, and Harvard Divinity School.

Having been ordained by the Presbytery of Carlisle in 1965, Bob has been serving Christ as a pastor, Bible teacher, and executive director for 59 years. His specialty for 15 of those years was as an Interim Pastor during which time he served seven different congregations in Connecticut, Indiana, and Pennsylvania.

Dotty is a Registered Nurse, R.N., having graduated from the Presbyterian School of Nursing in Philadelphia. From 2003 to 2013 Bob and Dotty lived in Philadelphia where they provided homestays for 66 international students who came to Penn and Drexel from 13 different counties to learn English. Together, the Larsons have traveled the world visiting Europe, the Middle East, Africa, Asia, Australia/New Zealand, Central America, and soon, South America.


