





To date, \$75,988 has been pledged, of which \$68,220 has been received. This is approximately 43% of our goal of \$160,000. Every contribution helps secure the financial security and the future of First Presbyterian Church. If you have not yet pledged to this campaign, we ask that you prayerfully consider doing so in the coming weeks and months. It is not too late! This effort will continue through the month of May.
